CAMP PIOMINGO

gives kids the life-changing experience of overnight camp, where they learn more about nature, gain a greater sense of independence and build friendships and memories that will last a lifetime.

SCHOOL-AGE CHILD CARE/NTI (Non-Traditional Instruction)

provides a safe, enriching environment where kids in elementary and middle school can learn, grow and thrive during the critical hours before and after school.

CHESTNUT STREET SUPPORTIVE HOUSING

provides men with housing, food, case management and career resources to help them on the road to self-sufficiency.

SUMMER DAY CAMPS

provide kids with a variety of imaginative activities that make sure they are able to stay engaged and discover more about themselves and the world around them during the summer.

CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTERS & PRESCHOOL

focus on nurturing each child's development by building foundational skills, trusting relationships and self-esteem through our values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility.

SWIM LESSONS

save lives by giving people of all ages a life-long skill through certified instruction that emphasizes the importance of safety, confidence and endurance in the water.

LIVESTRONG AT THE YMCA

offers cancer survivors support to rebuild strength and confidence in a safe, supportive environment and empowers them to raise awareness for the fight against cancer.

Y-NOW MENTORING PROGRAM

works with youth, ages 11-15, who have a parent in prison, and provides the hope, confidence and courage they need to break the cycle of incarceration.

SAFE PLACE SERVICES SHELTER HOUSE & STREET OUTREACH

offers a free, temporary residential shelter to homeless and vulnerable youth and young adults. Provides mediation and essential resources for the youth and their families.

YMCA BLACK ACHIEVERS & YMCA YOUTH ACHIEVERS

motivates students K-12th grade to strive for their full potential by developing skills to reach their education and career goals.

SAFETY AROUND WATER PROGRAM

is a free summer program designed to reach children at risk of drowning and teach them basic water safety skills to keep them safe in and around the water.

YOUTH & ADAPTIVE SPORTS PROGRAMS

strive to give every child the opportunity to build skills, gain confidence and learn teamwork while having fun and staying active through participation in team sports.

The YMCA of Greater Louisville responded to the COVID-19 pandemic with the following programs and services offered during and after our closures.

COVID-19 TESTING SITE

We are proud to have partnered with Norton Healthcare to offer drive-thru COVID-19 testing at our Republic Bank Foundation YMCA.

SENIOR WELLNESS CHECKS

During our facility closures, we felt their absence keenly and made concerted efforts to reach out to them to ensure they had support while safer at home.

EMERGENCY CHILD CARE

We provided child care for essential workers, first responders and health care professionals. Through that experience, we learned how to care for kids in a way that is safe, but that also attends to the needs of children for play and socializing.

CAMP PIOMINGO

This year, camp staff had to make the heartbreaking decision to suspend all 2020 summer programming. A program typically serving over 1,000 kids and teens, will look forward to the summer of 2021 to resume their programming.

NTI & SCHOOL-AGE CHILD CARE

\$80

When schools closed, and activities were suddenly canceled, children had to adapt to online learning. Our staff has stepped up to serve **over 741 children** by helping students log into school work and assisting with the material when possible.

CHESTNUT STREET SUPPORTIVE HOUSING



During our closure, **41 men** in our shelter had and still have a place to stay. In a time of so much uncertainty, we were fortunate to continue serving this community of individuals.

SUMMER DAY CAMPS

\$150

A summer camp experience was more important than ever for kids who had been at home for months. Camp gave **over 2,500 kids** a place to connect with peers, try new things, and learn through experiences.

CHILD DEVELOPMENT & PRESCHOOL

In 2020, over **389 children** still had the opportunity to learn, thrive, and grow in our preschools by safely utilizing creativity and learning essential life-long skills.

SWIM LESSONS

We wanted to be sure to continue offering swim lessons for our youth in whatever setting was appropriate for social distancing. We recreated our swim lessons with health and safety in mind to offer life-saving swimming skills for over **2,300 swimmers**.

LiveSTRONG at the YMCA

While the LiveSTRONG at the YMCA program could not meet in person in 2020, participants had a variety of virtual options available, including live exercise classes, cooking classes and prayer groups. We are looking forward to resuming the program in 2021.

Y-NOW MENTORING PROGRAM

Y-NOW continued to serve **61 teens** during our facility shutdowns. They utilized teleconferencing opportunities to assist in providing meaningful case management and support. A new cohort has recently started back up this fall.

SAFE PLACE SERVICES SHELTER HOUSE & STREET OUTREACH

Homeless or neglected teens were with us at our Safe Place Shelter every day since our closures in March. Safe Place never stopped receiving referrals and served over **254 youth** in our shelter house and **67 young adults** in the homeless drop-in center.

YMCA BLACK ACHIEVERS & YMCA YOUTH ACHIEVERS

\$645

This year, **169 Black Achievers** and **69 Youth Achievers** went virtual! Since June, these students have continued preparing for their futures and career aspirations, regardless of the pandemic's obstacles and uncertainties.

SAFETY AROUND WATER PROGRAM

\$50
per child

Traditionally, this program takes place during the summer, where thousands of children have the opportunity to learn life-saving skills in and around water. Because of our facility closures we had to suspend programming for 2020.

YOUTH & ADAPTIVE SPORTS PROGRAMS

Parents are concerned about their children remaining healthy and safe during this time while they continue to benefit from confidence, skills, and fun that the youth sports at the YMCA bring. In 2020, we served over **3,800 children** in our sports programs.

COVID-19 TESTING SITES

We have partnered with Norton Healthcare to at our Republic Bank Foundation YMCA to test **250 individuals** each day.

EMERGENCY CHILD CARE

Six area locations offered emergency childcare for essential workers, caring for more than **2,500 children**.

SENIOR WELLNESS CHECKS

We have always treasured the seniors who use our facilities for fellowship and wellness. Our YMCA volunteers and staff called more than **1,200 seniors** for wellness checks.
